Student Scholarship

The ISA Education Foundation (“Foundation”) was formed to advance education related to personal property appraising and to assist individuals through education development and improve their capabilities in personal property appraising. In furtherance of its mission, the Foundation has developed the ISA Education Foundation Student Scholarship. Each year, the Foundation intends to award between one and six \$500-\$1000 scholarships to students enrolled at an accredited university, college, junior college, or community college. These scholarships will be awarded to students majoring in art history, museum sciences or other majors that support a future career as a professional personal property appraiser.

Awards will be based on scholastic achievement, financial need, character, leadership and the candidate’s commitment to and interest in personal property appraising. The scholarships may be used for:

- Tuition at the university, college, junior college, or community college at which the candidate is enrolled; or
- Educational courses, seminars, or programs related to personal property appraising, but separate from a candidate’s degree program.

If you are qualified and interested in a career within the personal property appraising profession, please complete and submit a copy of the attached application to the ISA Education Foundation at the given letterhead address.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- Currently enrolled at an accredited community college, junior college, college or university
- GPA of 3.0 out of a possible 4.0 GPA for all course work completed to date.
- Art history, fine art, museum science, gemology or similar declared majors which tend to support a career in personal property appraising.
- Expressed interest in the personal property appraising profession.
- Demonstrated financial need.
- Scholarship must be used for tuition in connection with a degree program or in connection with an educational course related to personal property appraising
- Directors, officers, and employees of the International Society of Appraisers and the ISA Education Foundation, members of the ISA Education Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee and their relatives are not eligible to apply for ISA Education Foundation Scholarships.
